### **The Polar Code – How does it affect me and my ships?**

Wednesday 30th May 2018: 10.00 AM CEST

The IMO Polar Code has entered into force; this means that all SOLAS vessels planning to operate inside the geographical area defined in the Polar Code have to comply with it and have a valid Polar Ship Certificate on board.

As the Polar Code is a goal-based standard, there are some challenges when it comes to interpreting the different requirements and finding the right solutions for a planned operation. The requirements for the vessel, equipment and crew will also depend on the planned polar operation profile, as defined by the owner/operator.

This Smart-Up will be delivered by Morten Mejlaender-Larsen who has followed the development of the Code from the beginning and is today responsible for its implementation in DNV GL. He will present some of the main challenges and possible practical solutions related to complying with the Code as well as an overview of the process leading to the delivery of a Polar Ship Certificate.
